<p>Care Leaver and Estranged Students Bursary</p>	<p>“any 16 – 21 year old (or until the end of an agreed programme of education or training) who has been looked after for at least 13 weeks since the age of 14 and who is still looked after or recently left care, and/or who is no longer in contact with their parents and is able to evidence this through a signed letter from, for example, a teacher, social worker or counsellor.”</p>	<p>Awarded to all eligible students</p>	<p>Self-identify as a care leaver or estranged student.
