About Fábrica

Fábrica is raw, precise and physical. A ritual of repetition, intensity and transformation. In *Fábrica*, choreographer Guilherme Miotto aims to reshape the stage into a workshop of rhythm and movement. With three dancers (+2 acrobatic performers) and two live percussionists, we build a world where movement and sound are inseparable, where every action resonates and every rhythm is felt through in the body. With percussion as the beating heart of *Fábrica*, as oxygen for connection, bodies become instruments and instruments become extensions of the performers.

About our Participation Projects

Corpo Máquina Society develops participation projects which are focused on bringing a variety of groups and individuals together through movement and performance. Within these projects we approach the body as a base to connect people, regardless of age and background.
